PHOTOGRAPHING/VIDEO TAPING/PUBLISHING

During the year photographs and/or video may be taken for use in public relations and school-related publications. School personnel, including all LISD programs, are authorized to supervise possible photographing or videotaping of your child(ren) related to classes and school activities on school grounds or for school events. The reproduction of videos or photos may be done electronically and in print by administration or designee for these purposes. If you wish to opt out of having your child(ren) videotaped or photographed, please contact the Student Services Office.

USE OF STUDENT INFORMATION

During the year students are awarded honors for academics, activities, and other miscellaneous items. In such event, the district, including all LISD programs, will authorize local businesses to publicize these accomplishments through electronic or printed media. District and LISD program personnel will authorize the use of only pertinent information without jeopardizing the security of any child. If you do not wish to have your child(ren)'s information allowed for these purposes, please contact the Student Services Office.

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION--INTRA-DISTRICT

During the year students are transported on Britton Deerfield Schools yellow buses for field trips, assemblies, and other special programs between the Britton building and the Deerfield building. When traveling intra-district, individual permissions slips are NOT collected for each child. If you do NOT want your child(ren) to be transported for these events on a Britton Deerfield bus, please contact the Student Services Office.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

In case of accident involving injury, or suspected injury, or in the case of illness involving Britton Deerfield students, district and all LISD programs school staff will transport or secure an ambulance to transport a child(ren) to the nearest available emergency room when on school property or when away on school-related activities. School personnel will authorize an emergency room doctor to treat the child and/or call another doctor for consult and treatment in the event special treatment is necessary, such as surgery, orthopedics, etc. School personnel will hold this authorization as long as the student is enrolled in the Britton Deerfield Schools.

STUDENT HANDBOOK

Included in the student's handbook are policies that guide the district staff in providing a safe and orderly atmosphere in which all students can learn. Some of the policies are included in their entirety, whereas only sections of some lengthy policies are included. Copies of complete policies are available in the business office or are available on the school website at www.bdschools.us. Please request a copy of any school policy any time you have a question or concern. Please read the Handbook in its entirety with your child(ren) and discuss these rules.

PESTISIDE USE

Pesticides are periodically applied to school district property as part of the district's pest management program. Parents and legal guardians of children enrolled in the district have the right to request prior

notification of pesticide applications to the buildings and grounds. In order to be notified prior to the application process, the parent or legal guardian must request and return a "Pesticide Prior Notification Request Form."
