## Michigan law requires that children entering kindergarten have a vision and hearing screening prior to school entrance.

The Lenawee County Health Department and the Michigan Department of Public Health sponsor a hearing and vision program for pre-school children. They are interested in testing the hearing and vision of all children 3 through 5 years of age, especially all who will enter kindergarten in the fall. This service is being provided without cost to the parents. A report and recommendation concerning each child will be given to parents following the testing.

A surprising number of children have vision or hearing difficulties that are not even suspected. Many are found through the vision or hearing screening test and referred to a doctor. Defects are much easier to correct at an early age and some permanent handicaps can be prevented.
